### LANGUAGE OUTREACH PROGRAM GRADUATION

Celebrate the students of Reach's Language Outreach Program (LOP) on Friday evening, June 18th. The program will begin at 7:00 p.m. and everyone is invited to attend.

For the second year, this annual event will be held virtually. For the first time, sponsorship opportunities are being offered (see opportunities <u>HERE</u>). LOP is facing a \$30,000 shortfall in expenses versus pledged funding for the 2021-22 academic year. Sponsor funds will be used to lessen the shortfall and avoid a cut in services.

The celebration will be held through a Zoom webinar and will include messages from students, teachers, teacher assistants, Montgomery County and City of Rockville VIPs, and more. Certificates are being mailed to the students since they will not be able to walk across the stage. As they did last year, many students will provide photos of themselves with their certificates to be shown during the program. Seeing the students dressed up and celebrating their accomplishments in this way was very moving at last year's ceremony and is expected to be so again this year. LOP staff are working on interesting and innovative ways to make the event interactive so students feel the power and pride of the community in their accomplishments.

## KASEMAN HEALTH CLINIC COVID SERVICE UPDATES

In late April, Reach's Kaseman Health Clinic (MKHC) began offering COVID-19 vaccines to both Clinic patients and all other Montgomery County residents who are eligible to be vaccinated. Appointments are required and can be made by calling MKHC at 301-917-6800 between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Vaccination appointments are offered for Thursday afternoons.



MKHC continues to hold drive-up COVID-19 testing on Saturdays at Rockville United Methodist Church and on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of each month at Rockville United Church.

There will be **no testing over Memorial Day weekend**, May 29-31. Currently testing will continue through June, when the Clinic, with Montgomery County and the other partner organizations of Por Nuestra Salud y Bienestar, will decide whether the number of COVID-19 testing sites should be reduced. Montgomery County continues to urge residents who have been exposed to COVID or have COVID-19 symptoms to get tested.



**JOIN A REACH COMMITTEE** - Development, Finance, Faith Advisory, and Governance currently all meet online as standing committees. Help determine the success of Reach through your service. Short term committees also need new members. We will soon be assembling a committee to plan the MKHC fundraiser scheduled for late October 2021.

**WRITER/EDITOR/INVESTIGATOR** to help build out our procedures manual for a few departments and programs that are not yet completed. Interview staff to determine how tasks are accomplished and who is responsible for what. Help staff document their work processes in layman's terms and then put it in writing for them.

CLIENT INTAKE COORDINATORS for Rockville Emergency Assistance Program (REAP). Are you a compassionate, detail-oriented person with a desire to help those in need? Work a four-hour shift weekly during business hours (ideally from 9:00 a.m. -1:00 p.m. or 1:00 p.m. -5:00 p.m.) to help us assist Rockville residents facing eviction; provide County residents with referrals for low-cost dental and other services; and much more. Training is provided. Volunteers may also be able to assist remotely by collecting information from callers and providing basic answers.

**INTERPRETERS** at the Kaseman Health Clinic are needed for four-hour shifts once each week between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Help us ensure that our providers and patients can communicate clearly. Confidentiality is required.
